


A New View Phal Tithlyhong Sin Thuokna

One day, there is a big festival in the village, but his dad is sick and cannot go. Tulu's father asks him to go instead as a photographer.




At the festival, Tulu sees animals dancing, singing, and eating. Which group should he photograph first? He decides to start with a family of elephants. That was easy!

But the mice are still unhappy with the photographs.




As Tulu is talking to the mice, trying to decide on another way to photograph them, a parade comes up behind him.




Before he realizes what is happening, the parade runs right into Tulu! He is knocked to the ground.
