"I want to make an airplane. Just do not touch anything, ok? And do not bother me." Panha frowns, "But I want to do it too."




Nita rolls her eyes. "Do not bother me, ok? Go and play by yourself."


"But Daddy bought this for both of us."

Nita still cannot do it. In frustration, she shouts out: "Why does it not look like an airplane?!"




Nita turns around to see Panha arranging his blocks by himself.



Nita gets an idea. She starts rearranging.




She moves so fast!
